#### Hume Planning Scheme Amendment C198: Craigieburn North Employment Area PSP and DCP

A Directions Hearing was held on 6 October 2015 at Planning Panels Victoria in relation to the above Amendment. A copy of the Panel's Directions and Hearing Timetable are attached. The following key dates are relevant to this matter:

- Merrifield Corporation to confirm expert witnesses to be called by close of business on Tuesday 13 October 2015. Best Hooper should also advise representation for Merrifield Corporation by this date.
- Expert witness reports must be circulated by 2.00pm on Wednesday 4 November 2015
- The MPA should circulate its Part A submission by 2.00pm on Wednesday 4 November 2015.
- MPA should provide to all submitters, its response to issues raised by them in their submissions by close of business on Friday 16 October 2015
- Submitters should inform the MPA by Monday 26 October 2015 whether any or all of the
  outstanding issues raised by them in submissions have been resolved to their satisfaction as
  set out in the document circulated by the MPA on 16 October 2015
- The Hearing will commence at 10.00am Monday 16 November 2015

At the Hearing, Professor Eade indicated that he had served on the Standard Development Contributions Advisory Committee with Bryce Moore a principal of Moremac, Property Group, a submitter, some two and a half years ago. Mr Harty indicated he has had various Panel and VCAT involvement in Hume and past private consulting work with EnPlan Partners for Hume City Council associated with a Farm Land Status Audit for land management & rural rate rebates in 2012. The audit was not planning related and did not involve land within the UGB or UGZ in the City of Hume.

#### Written Submissions at the Hearing

- 1. All parties should bring to the Hearing at least six (6) hard copies of additional written submissions and accompanying documents (i.e. photographs, plans). Copies of original submissions are not needed.
- 2. Written material presented at the Hearing should be two-hole punched and stapled (not bound).
- 3. Submissions (preferably in MS Word) should be emailed to the Panel after the Hearing at planning.panels@delwp.vic.gov.au.
- 4. Submissions and material presented at the Hearing including PowerPoint presentations are public documents and may be made available to other parties.

#### **Exchange of Expert Witness Reports**

- 5. Expert witnesses reports must comply with the Planning Panels Victoria Guide to Expert Evidence (<a href="http://www.dtpli.vic.gov.au/planning/panels-and-committees/planning-panel-guides-and-faqs">http://www.dtpli.vic.gov.au/planning/panels-and-committees/planning-panel-guides-and-faqs</a>).
- 6. Expert witness reports should not refer to any individual submitter by name. If necessary, submitters may be referred to by submission number.
- 7. Expert witnesses reports must be circulated by **2.00pm on Wednesday 4 November 2015** (**both** Hard **and** Electronic copies) in accordance with the attached Distribution List.
- 8. A copy of any expert witness report received must be made available on the MPA's website and at its office.

#### Information to be supplied

- 9. The MPA must circulate to all parties on the distribution list its 'Part A Submission' by **2.00pm on Wednesday 4 November 2015**. This should include:
  - a. Background to the Amendment
  - b. Chronology of events
  - c. Strategic context and assessment
  - d. Identification of the issues raised in submissions and its response
  - e. Changes to the Amendment documentation proposed as a result of the issues raised in submissions
  - f. A table outlining each of the unresolved issues raised by submitters, its response to each unresolved issue and its proposed action

Note: At the Hearing, Council's 'Part A Submission' will be taken as read by all parties. Council should allow time on Day 1 for questions of clarification from the Panel.

- 10. At the Hearing, the MPA must address the following issues through its 'Part B Submission'
  - a. A summary of the key issues raised in submissions
  - b. Response to evidence tabled
  - c. Its final position on the Amendment
  - d. The results of the conclave on bridge design and costs which met as a result of the Whittlesea C183 process
  - e. Details of other current permit applications applicable



- f. The basis for the proposal to provide Commercial Zone land when the North Growth Corridor Plan indicates the land as Industrial
- g. A strategic justification for the selection of the RCZ to be applied in the Growling Grass Frog Area
- h. A response to the impact on those properties that are wholly affected by the application of the RCZ and the implications for land use and development from designation of such lands for conservation purposes to protect and buffer the Growling Grass Frog habitat.
- i. Clarification of calculations associated with the Public Land Equalisation Method (PLEM) in the DCP with particular reference to figures in section 3.2.3 page 23 and Table 8 and apparent inconsistencies between the table and the text.
- 11. At the Hearing, the MPA should arrange for:
  - a. A map showing the location of submitters by submitter number. This map:
    - i. must not show submitter names
    - ii. does not need to show the location of pro-forma submitters
  - iii. must not be placed on the internet or replicated in any report.
  - b. Appropriate aerials and plans, including zoning plans, at large scale
  - c. Access to the MPA or Council's GIS maps/system.
- 12. Prior to the Hearing, officers from the MPA and Council should meet to attempt to resolve any outstanding issues and agree which if any issues remain unresolved. Ideally this should occur prior to 16 October 2015
