Well I have carefully read through the Growth Plan—while there are many themes you have provided few solutions

■—Keep the rural “vibe”---HOW ??—adding another 10000 residents simply turns us into yet another urban area.

Retail -again there is NO land currently available in the township for retail activities and you may be surprised to learn that you cannot buy a pair of shoes let alone white goods,home furnishings or even a TV in Bannockburn.

As I pointed out in my original submission there should be a hold on developments until both the Midland and Hamilton highways are upgraded to allow for adequate traffic flows especially for the log trucks—grain trucks—and all the other trucks who use the C143 as their route from the west to Geelong. The proposed arterial road along the power line easement would be a great start but I fear that will be put on hold for at least a decade. There was no mention of any upgrade to Burnside Road which in the “short term” would be the only road servicing the South East development—maybe an “oversight”

The State Government’s recent proposed changes to Planning remove any hope of achieving a equitable outcome for communities.

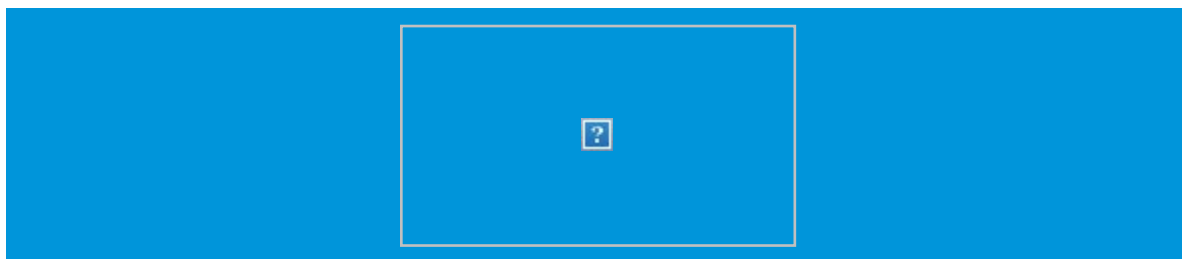
I wish you well however I will be voting with my feet.
