A major risk factor accelerated by climate change is food and water insecurity around the world. So designing for maximum water infiltration and retention in the soil, via streets being placed on contour and with vegetated swales, or soak- in gutters, to enable maximum tree cover for micro-climate comfort, and to grow strongest food trees, will be increasingly valuable.

70% tree canopy with understory, compared to 20%, can reduce temperature by 10 degrees, so will save distress and lives in the coming decades.

Energy and resource efficient building techniques, like eaves over north-facing windows, should be required by regulation.

Encouraging the sharing of community space, diverse street orchards and diverse park orchards, will strengthen the community. And help the cultural shift all humanity will need to undergo. Thank you.
