

The Victorian Planning Authority (VPA) and/or consultant specialists contracted by the VPA may require access to your landholding to undertake technical studies to inform development of the Casey Fields South and Devon Meadows PSP and ICP. Access remains entirely at the landowner's discretion, however, failure to provide access may lead to uncertainty and/or additional costs being incurred by the landowner at the time of development.

If you decide to provide consent to access your property, the VPA and/or its representatives will:

- a) make reasonable efforts to contact the occupier(s) via their preferred phone number prior to accessing the property;
- b) take all reasonable care to minimise impact to the property; and
- c) take direction concerning access to land where stock is present.
