

Thank you for highlighting the need for people-focussed streets and areas. Our family (2x adults, 2x kids) usually use bicycle for transport and shopping, or otherwise PT. Presently Preston Market is quite inaccessible to us, which is a shame because we like the offerings at the market, but don't often visit. Even the times we have driven, we have find it quite scary navigating the car park.

I fully support the idea of a 'people street' and ask that this is executed to a very high quality. Too often Australian examples are still very car focussed, or of low quality, or even just end up as 'stroads'. Our bicycle identity which includes wearing armour and hi-viz for cycling seem to green-light poor quality street-scapes. Look to far-reaching European examples,

where riding a bike is akin to a stroll to the shops. For many, the bike is a ride-on shopping trolley! That is, don't perpetuate our "helmetfrastructure" approach and instead build a street that is fully welcoming and *protective* of people walking, scooting, cycling. It should be an *enjoyable* experience to really maximise the number of people walking, cycling, etc.

Minimize cross-overs, driveways and blank streets. Instead of ventilation shafts, driveways and fire cabinets, the street should present cafes, retail and nature. The plans look good, and I am excited about the redevelopment plans. Good work.
