I wish to submit my concerns about the preston market development:

- significant increase in traffic on residential streets, in radius of development and surroundings. This will also impact pedestrian safety within those residential streets and main roads.
- significant reduction in open space available within central Preston .
- privacy and overshadowing of surround properties and houses due to the heights of proposed buildings.
- concerned existing single lane Roads and infrastructure not adequately equipped for the number of proposed new residence (from the new towers).
- overhaul of the intersection of Murray and spring st given the increase in traffic will be significant (parking etc).
- pedestrian overpasses required to avoid crossing St. George's/ spring st Preston.

- limited parking available already in surrounding streets, shoppers etc already parking in side streets. This will further increase.
- building heights are far too high for Preston landscape 5-6 would be maximum per tower but still need more infrastructure (extend tram line to Murray rd from Miller st)
