There is no elevation of the market plans that I could find . My suggestions are several

1) design the Market to operate on several levels that match or nearly match the height of the apartment buildings. Since there isn't an elevated plan of the overall design

2) use the same materials with which customers are already familiar

- canvas canopy
- the thick framework of poles that hold up the existing canopy. These would be used for handrails, frames of the stores and the staircases to each level.
- recycled timber for walls in the stalls
- same style of signage - chalkboards etc

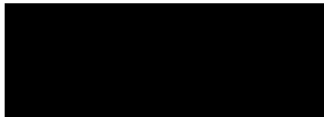
3) retain natural light by using aerial walkways

Practical aspects of the multilevel market:

Elevators bring customers & goods to the upper levels.

Recyclable waste is dropped down separate chutes

Water is collected & filtered through to the ground floor



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
