The popularity of the Clayton Reserve off-lead dog park is also described.

It is anticipated that there will be many dog-owners in the Arden development. There is. no mention made of outdoor areas reserved for dogs such as off-lead spaces. One could assume that Clayton Reserve and the limited off-lead area of the North Melbourne Recreation Reserve are the areas within Arden that the planners will rely on for dogs to play with others.

I suggest that new off-lead areas be included within Arden. While Melbourne City Council may have plans to provide off-lead areas in surrounding suburbs this isn't referred to in the Arden Structure Plan and it should at a minimum.
