There is significant community concern about the Beveridge North West Precinct Structure

Plan (C158). The plan proposes approving the introduction of a quarry in the midst of a planned and fast growing development zone, which will have a deleterious effect on residents (both human and animal) of the region.

Mitchell Shire Council has reflected residents position on the quarry, and has twice rejected the related planning application at 175 Northern Highway because:

- it will bring traffic congestion to an already extremely busy set of roads;
- it will increase noise, and dust to what is becoming a heavily populated suite of communities, impacting the health and wellbeing of residents;
- the vibrations associated with the proposed quarry will impact our communities.

I urge careful consideration of the impact that the proposed quarry will have on the nearby well established and rapidly growing communities, and recommend a judgement against the planning application.
