My house is around .5 km from proposed quarry which means for the next 20 years my house will be subjected to enormous amounts of blasting or rock breakers which will accelerate the aging process of my house.

#### SEEMS TO BE A PATTERN HERE

The urban development should not have been allowed to proceed or should have been halted had urban development started until BNW draft plan had been settled. I have no idea the number of homes that will be effected by this plan by the way of blasting or the use of excavators with hammer attachment. This means for the next twenty years that blasting or the use of rock breakers will be driving families up the wall.

Urban development should not have been allowed to proceed until the ground had been analysed and the uses defined before development of any sort had been started.

Huge mistake VPA to consider this Plan.

So far I have not seen any comment in regards to compensation for either damage to our homes and the mental torment of rock breakers or blasting being carried out six or seven days a week for twenty years.
