I object to the proposed Quarry.

The Northern Hwy has been identified as major traffic problem during afternnon peak periods with vehicles backing up onto the North bound freeway lanes causing accidents and near misses.

Current and past Governments repeatly have made commitments to have a Walln and Kilmore bypass built without any result.

The additional traffic south bound from the proposed Quarry site using traffic lights or outhr alternatives will cause further traffic conjection due to uphill approach to the Hume Freeway. Ambulance attendance will be impacted to emergencies on the Hume Freeway due to additional traffic lights and slow moving traffic created by Trucks exiting and entering the proposed Quarry.

The Quarry will have emissions of dust and noise as well as dropping Quarry waste onto the roadway, this is already a problem causing windscreen damage to vehicles and creating slippery road surfaces causing more accidents, I have already replaced 2 winsscreens due to Quarry trucks leaving site without cleaning the Dog Trailer draw bar.

The location will most certainly be an blight on the landscape and in current view of many new homes who have built near the location.

Exhaust fumes from Quarry equipment will emit noxious fumes and are not subject to EPA regulations for emissions just like the Diesel Trains (Southern Cross Station has diesel exhaust emission which exceeds Australian Standards for human exposure)

The voting public who live close to the proposed Quarry had no knowledge prior to purchase of this proposed development and it is not consistant with our wishes to live in a clean semi rural envirnoment.

Should the application be granted you can expect protests at the next election and the establishment of an active protest group to delay and overturn the development.
