Dear Sir Madam,

I am writing to you in regards to the Officer South Employment precinct.

Hopefully you are not in discussions with the local council with regards to this, as they are absolutely hopeless in getting anything done

I understand that you have to follow certain guidelines as set by the disability discrimination Act such as being able to push straight into a shop or office. It's also other smaller things that make a difference, such as pedestrian crossing at intersections be accessible from all sides (there are examples in Officer where I can not go straight across the road, due to curb, so have to cross to opposite side, then cross there and finally to the side intended to get to, so three road crossings, where it simply could have been one). And please keep in mind those who still use self-propelled wheelchairs, gravel/stones can be hard if not impossible to push over, an example is a footpath on the west side of Officer train station, stops approximately 40m from station Street, it's impossible to push over to get to the train station.

I know these examples have naught to do with you, but hopefully you can use as an example for any planning.
