				I also don't see mention of a library. Perhaps a pop up library or

				Amphitheatre:		
				In the middle of medium density housing area it would be nice to		
				see an amphitheatre or public gathering space for children and		
				adults co-located with the community centre. A place to bring the		
				community together, to hold community events.		

Location of the Neighbourhood Activity Centre (NAC): My concern is that it is positioned on Gillies Road which is a major road. It is marked as a signalised intersection - not clear to me if this means a roundabout. Concerned that there does not seem to be any plans to mitigate risks for people crossing on foot or by car. Garage: I don't see any land earmarked for a future garage- one that can accommodate electric vehicle charging, which people may not be able to do at their house. Shared path (dotted lines): The shared path does not connect on either side of Gillies. It would make sense to have it transverse the whole community. High school students I assume would access the shared path to reach school whether they are east or west of Gillies Street. Bird life: Lots of treed spaces and waterways will help. It will not just be local birds but also birds travelling through. For instance it is known that ibis regular fly between Lake Wendouree and Creswick. There will be other birds. Transport Ensuring people can get from Ballarat North to Wendouree Shopping Centre and railway station and Ballarat proper by public transport needs to be factored in from the early planning stages.
