The Traffic reports by SMEC and Jacobs are considered deficient as they have not considered these key issues.

Why has so much community infrastructure been placed on the Ballarat Grammar School site (i.e sports field and pavilion and wetland basin).

I looking to still review the groundwater contamination reports as the NGA is located incorporates a former landfill adjoining the Burrumbeet Creek (similar for Cultural Heritage Assessments). The GHD buffer adverse impact amenity assessment is considered inadequate as the required technical reports have not been finalised. It hasn't fully considered the Midland Highway industrial estate and the potential for further noxious industries to establish. Noise monitoring has not been undertaken. Ballarat currently has an industrial land supply shortage – why jeopardise what little is left? Why are industries being encouraged to reduce emissions to make the growth area work (GHD p92 Mitigation Measures).

The buffer information provided around the Ballarat North Sewerage Treatment Plant needs to clearly state the following

- Existing required buffers based on Ballarat's population
- Required buffers for Ballarat's future population expansion
- Not be dependent on other reports from CHW not provided as

part of the amendment documents
I note the DCP includes Midland Highway duplication north of the freeway (interesting bearing in mind the highway to the south is not yet duplicated.
I consider the next train station in Ballarat should be adjacent to Mars Stadium.
Have the main roads been designed to maximise view lines to Mount Rowan as Sturt Street and Mair street have been designed 170 years ago to maximise views.
The amendment seems to have been exhibited prematurely.
