I don't want thousands of new neighbours. I love the peace and quiet. I know I'll probably be told that the develop doesn't affect me but honestly it affects me in many ways.
It is already dangerous enough to enter my driveway due to cars travelling fast along Wangoom road. I'm assuming it's all going to be reduced to 60km/hr which is good but the number of times cars don't see me stopped in the middle of the road waiting to turn right I was told this was going to fixed when the corner of Horne and Wangoom was redone but it wasn't.
Is the access point from Dixon's lane going to be preserved? Currently it has electric fencing over it which prevents me from using without having to struggle to remove it. My neighbours put it in place to graze cattle.
